The Fiji Institute of Accountant will be hosting the outreach meeting of the Professional Accountancy Organising Development Committee (PAODC) in Nadi from 17-19 August 2017.

"This is an opportune time to discuss matters of interest to FIA where the Confederation of Asian & Pacific Accountants (CAPA) could be of assistance," said FIA President Finau Nagera.

"Few of the matters of interest that the Institute will raise include:

- Accounting Standards what area of assistance could CAPA provide in the area of the new accounting standards that will become effective over the next few years;
- Appropriate development process particularly of single partners as has been identified in our peer review and seek assistance from well-heeled Institutes. Broader discussion and request for assistance could give us the broader support."

ABOUT PAO DEVELOPMENT

One of the key focus areas for CAPA is to assist professional accountancy organisations (PAOs) develop, grow and mature, as reflected in our Mission Statement.

PAOs are membership bodies comprised of individual professional accountants, auditors, and/or accounting technicians who perform a variety of roles in the accountancy field and adhere to high quality standards of practice. When PAOs function properly they have the ability to provide and maintain accountants to effectively meet the needs of the country in which they operate. This, in turn, supports the production of high quality financial information, which contributes to public and private sector development and has the power to drive economic growth, the effectiveness of international aid, and social progress.

Recognising the vital role that accountants play in establishing confidence in all economies CAPA works with key stakeholders in the accountancy profession and development partners to assist PAOs and to promote the value of professional accountants across the region. CAPA formed the Professional Accountancy Organisation Development Committee (PAODC) in 2012 to lead such initiatives.
